## GreenFilm Fest Submission Details:

Climate Change, Green Jobs, Clean Technology, Sustainable Energy: What are they? What are their stories? Submit a video that tells the story from your perspective: how you understand the problems we face, about a project or innovative company in your community, interviews with people who are working in the field, interviews with people outside the field about their beliefs and opinions. The possibilities are endless. . .

Video entries must follow the simple rules listed below. Selected entries will be presented at the GreenFilm pavillion at Boston GreenFest 2009, August 21-22. Some entries may be recognized at special pre-screening or other events.

Videos may be in any of several categories: Public Services Announcements, 30-60 seconds; micro-docs, 1 to 2 minutes; shorts, 4-6 minutes; or feature length: 15-30 minutes. They can be in the form of a promotional spot, a documentary, a videoed creative piece (e.g. music or dance); a fictional story, a documentary, or an educational tutorial. The arts have always been an avenue for effective and meaningful communication: the best work engages the viewer, and tells a story (whether fact or fiction) in a clear and compelling way. Use your imagination!!

### Rules and guidelines: -

- Submit your video on a CD in one of the common digital video file formats, one submission per disc. Acceptable files are: .avi (preferred for best quality), .mov, and .mpg. ***PLEASE NOTE: it is important to send us the video files themselves, and not an encoded DVD format, so that we can copy them for projection.***
- Save at the highest resolution settings available, so that your submission is appropriate for projection on a large screen, not just for playback on a laptop or mobile device.
- Videos must be postmarked by July 31, 2009. Send to: The Foresight Project, Box 874, Ayer, MA, 01432.
- Each video must be accompanied by a hard-copy submission form and by a permission form (download forms below).
- In addition, a completed submission form should be e-mailed to [greenfilmfest.bgf@gmail.com](mailto:greenfilmfest.bgf@gmail.com) no later than midnight July 31, 2009. We will acknowledge receipt of the electronic form, and will be alerted to expect a video. If you have not received an acknowledgement within 24 hours of sending in the electronic form, please contact us immediately: 978.391.4479.
- Source of all material used in a video must be acknowledged in the credits; time required for credits should not be included in time listed for the video itself.
- Submitters must obtain signed release forms (download form below) from anyone appearing in their videos, and must have any permission required for the use of copyrighted material.
- Please note: There is NO submission fee required.
