GreenFilm Fest Submission Details:

Climate Change, Green Jobs, Clean Technology, Sustainable Energy: What are they? What are their stories? Submit a video that tells the story from your perspective: How you understand the problems we face; A project or an innovative company in your community; Interviews with people who are working in the field; Interviews with people outside the field about their beliefs and opinions – The possibilities are endless. . .

Your entry must follow the simple rules below. Selected entries will be presented at the GreenFilm pavilion at Boston GreenFest 2009, August 21-22. Some entries may be recognized at special pre-screening or other events.

Videos may be in any of several categories: Public Service Announcements, 30-60 seconds; Micro-Documentaries, 1-2 minutes; Shorts, 4-6 minutes; Feature length, 15-30 minutes. They can be in the form of a promotional spot, a fictional story, a documentary, an educational tutorial, or a videoed creative piece of music or dance. The arts have always been an avenue for effective and meaningful path to understanding: the best work engages the viewer and tells a story, whether fact or fiction, in a clear and compelling way. Use your imagination!!

Rules and guidelines: -

- Submit your video on a CD as a digital video file, one submission per disc. Preferred files are: .avi (for best quality), .mov, or .mpg. ***PLEASE NOTE: it is important to send us your video as a file, and not as an encoded DVD, so that we can transfer it for projection.***
- Save at the highest resolution settings available, so that your video is appropriate for projection on a large screen and not just for playback on a laptop or mobile device.
- Videos must be postmarked by July 31, 2009. Send your entry to: The Foresight Project, Box 874, Ayer, MA, 01432.
- Each video must be accompanied by a hard-copy submission form; note that submission of an entry signifies that you grant Boston GreenFest, The Foresight Project and Newbury Film Series the right to use your video for any purpose, including educational and promotional uses.
- In addition, e-mail a completed submission form (see below) to greenfilmfest.bgf@gmail.com no later than midnight July 31, 2009. We will be alerted to expect a video. We will acknowledge receipt of your e-mail; if you have not received an acknowledgement with 48 hours, please contact us immediately: 978.391.4479.
- Source of all material used in a video must be acknowledged in the credits; time required for credits should not be included in time listed for the video itself.
- For your own protection, please follow your school's guidelines in obtaining a release from anyone appearing in your video; you should follow school guidelines for required permission for the use of any copyrighted material.
- Note: There is NO submission fee.
